




2014 Chardonnay

NORTH COAST



2014 marks the third vintage in a row (count 'em!) that Mother Nature has seen fit to grace California with another banner harvest. Once again we got off to a warm, early start to Spring and enjoyed a fairly mild summer with a handful of heat spikes between late May and early August. Normal yields across the board led to a mid-August harvest and some perfectly ripe grapes. The Lake County fruit makes its mark per usual with hints of melon, while the Suisun fruit from just outside Napa delivers floral and citrus notes.



Light straw in color. On the nose, soft notes of persimmon, tropical and stone fruits, tangerine and vanilla. Secondary aromas of soft tangerine, lemon blossom, and banana cream pie. The bright palate showcases notes of minerality, tropical fruit, vanilla, and acid.
