

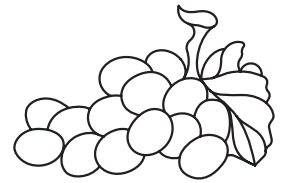
# ALPHA BOX & DICE

LOOKS LIKE	Toffee apples and Red Skins.
SMELLS LIKE	Strawberries and cream and red lollies.
TASTES LIKE	Sweet, rich and full body, white pepper, cherries, mulberries, Blackforest cake and a hint of brandy.
DRINK WITH	Everything and anything.
CELLAR FOR	Up to 10 years.
NUMBERS	ALCOHOL: 15.68% pH: 3.14 RESIDUAL SUGAR: 1.6g/L TOTAL ACIDITY: 6.86g/L
VINEYARD	Zuzolo Vineyard: Willunga Springfarm Vineyard, Bell Vineyard: Whites Valley.
SOIL	WHITES VALLEY: Red clay-loam over limestone. WILLUNGA: Brown clay-loam over limestone.
FERMENTATION	90% machine picked, destemmed, inoculated with a neutral yeast, fermented until dry on skins, no pressings. 10% hand picked, 100% whole bunch, wild fermentation on skins until dry.
MATURATION	Six months on lees in tank.
STYLE	The 2017's light hearted appearance has been matured in the 2018. A little bit richer, bolder and more of the darker fruit spectrum creeping in the 18 is everything you loved, just maxed out.
